

Condition Rating 1

1

No repair is currently needed. Normal maintenance must be carried out.

Condition Rating 2

2

Repairs or replacements are needed but the surveyor does not consider these to be serious or urgent.

Condition Rating 3



These are defects which are either serious and/or require urgent repair or replacement or the surveyor feels that further investigation is required. You may wish to obtain quotes for additional work where a condition rating 3 is given, prior to exchange of contract.
